
Arbitration

Arbitration is a way of resolving disputes without going to court. The parties pay a qualified arbitrator to hear the case and make a decision.

The major advantages are:

1. a decision can often be made much faster than through the court process
2. parties can select the decision maker
3. it is a more private process than a court hearing.
